DORMITION FAST

Please note the Dormition Fast in honor of the Falling Asleep of the Mother of God begins on Wednesday, August 1 and continues through Wednesday, August 15. The fasting rules are abstinence from meat, dairy, fish, wine and oil during weekdays. Wine and oil are allowed on the weekend. Fish, wine, and oil are permitted for the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord on the August 6. Please make time in your schedule to attend the weeknight Paraklesis services as well as those for Feasts during this period.
