**PROPER DISPOSAL OF
BLESSED ITEMS**

For blessed items (such as palms and palm crosses, flowers, etc.) that you may have at home, office, car, etc. but you no longer need or have been replaced, there is a proper method for their disposal. Bring these items to church between now and April 24. On that day, during the other activities of Lazarus Saturday, Fr. David will dispose of the blessed items properly.

PLEASE NOTE: Loose SAGO and other large PALM LEAVES are needed for Palm Sunday. If you have or can obtain any of these, please bring them to the church by Friday, April 23 or Saturday morning, April 24 (Saturday of Lazarus Divine Liturgy).

PASCHA PICNIC

As we emerge from some of our COVID restrictions, we are holding our annual Pascha Picnic after Agape Vespers on Pascha Sunday. This year, we are asking that this event be for our immediate parish family and we humbly ask our people to not invite additional guests.

All seating for the picnic will be outside and a tent will be provided for weather concerns. Due to restrictions prohibiting buffet-style meals, this year is NOT a carry-in potluck. The Parish Council is providing foods to be served by a serving line: lamb, fried chicken, hamburgers, hot dogs, brats, potato salad, macaroni & cheese, baked beans, roasted vegetables, raw vegetables, fruit, soft drinks & water. Desserts provided will be cake and individual ice cream.

No food brought from individual homes will be set out for the picnic.

There will be an egg hunt and lawn games are encouraged to be brought from home.
